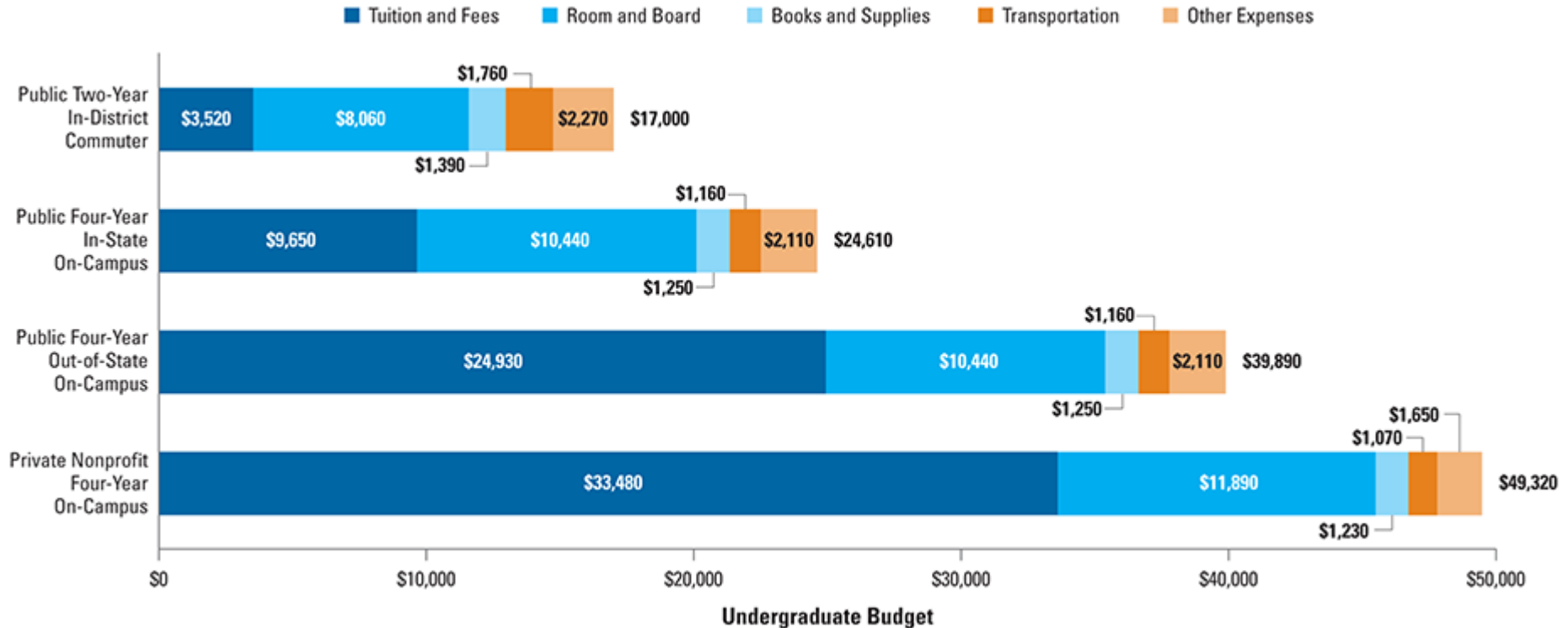

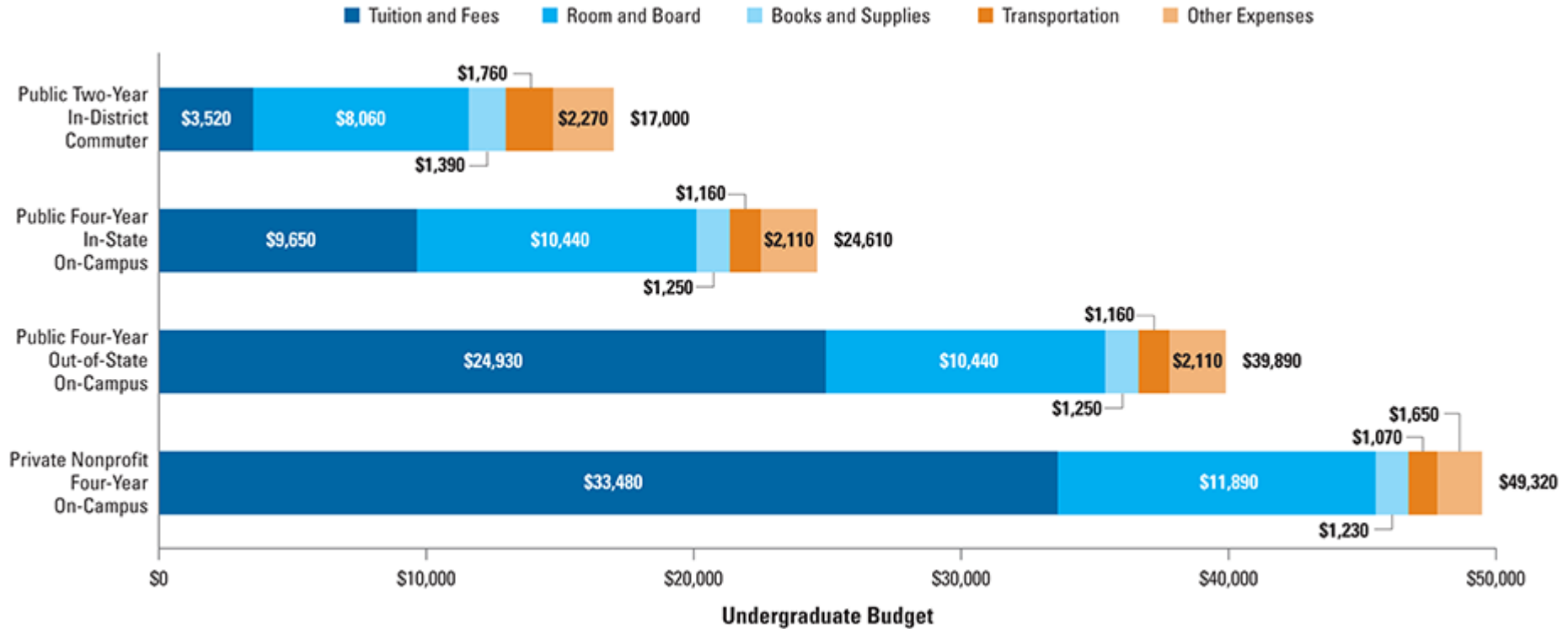

AFFORDABILITY

- Students can pay \$0 (or the reduced price of printing copies) for course materials

ACCESSIBILITY

- Students have access before, during, and beyond course duration

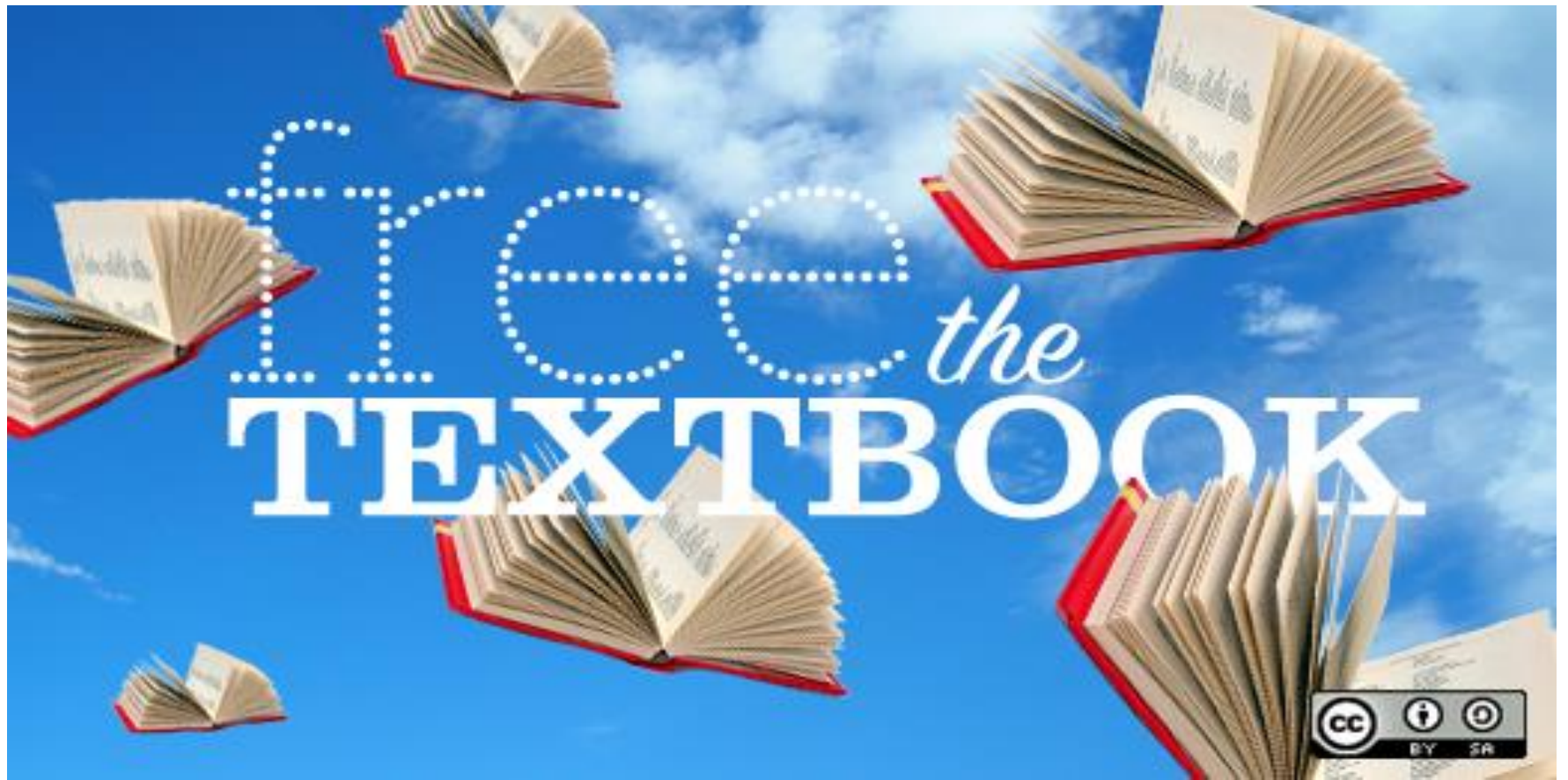
