

Clinton Tao (陶惟勛)

Clinton Tao started working at the Far Eastern Library in 1948, after he was invited to come here from the National Central Library in Taiwan. He was a Boone Library School graduate from Huachung University (literally “Central China University”) in Wuchang. Clinton was the first professional librarian working at the Far Eastern Library and his work was cataloging and reference.

Clinton left UW to join the staff of the Orientalia Division at the Library of Congress and then worked at the Arlington Public Library in Massachusetts until his retirement in the late 1970s.
