Tauchao (T.C.) Fan worked at the Far Eastern Library from 1947 to 1951, while he was a student at the University of Washington. T.C.'s work in the Far Eastern Library was mainly writing Chinese characters on cataloging cards.

T.C. left UW after his graduation in 1951 and went to graduate school at Stanford, majoring in aerophysics. He was later employed at Lockeed for a number of years. From 2003-2005 he was invited by Dean Denten and President McCormick to be a visiting scholar at UW.
